
**AMENDMENT**

Subject : Amendment to Saansad Adarsh Gram Yojana Guidelines issued on 11th October 2014

In exercise of the power conferred by the Cabinet while approving the Saansad Adarsh Gram Yojana and its guidelines, the Ministry hereby makes the following amendment in the Scheme Guidelines.

Para No.	Original Text	Revised Text
9 Sub para 1.	A Gram Panchayat would be the basic unit. It will have a population of 3000-5000 in plain areas and 1000-3000 in hilly, tribal and difficult districts. In districts where this unit size is not available, Gram Panchayats approximating the desirable population size may be chosen.	A Gram Panchayat would be the basic unit. It will have a population of 3000-5000 in plain areas and 1000-3000 in hilly, tribal and difficult districts. In districts where the average unit size is larger, Gram Panchayats approximating the desirable population size may be chosen. Further for districts having GPs where average unit size is smaller, two to three neighboring GPs approximating the desirable population can be adopted as one unit.
